Approach routes:

From the south of the river, through Hurley Village off the A4130 Henley to Maidenhead road at Hurley Bottom.

Car parking:


Public car park in Hurley village. **No parking at the lock.**

Toilets at the lock: Yes

Access to fishing site ():

From the car park, follow the pedestrian signs to the lock (approx. 250 yards).

Fishing site ():

From the banks of the main lock island, the camping island and from the lasher weir. The camping Island*, lasher weir* and banks of the lock cut (): are only available from 1 October to 31 March.

* Key required from the lock keeper for access.

Notes:

You can fish from the main lock island from dawn to dusk. However, please show your permit to the lock keeper once a day during duty hours. Fishing from the camping island and lasher weir is only allowed in lock keepers' hours of duty (see the guide to lock and weir fishing).

Special note:

Day tickets are available to fish the main lock island, however permit holders do not have to pay the day ticket charge.
