Cookham Lock information:
 Public access is by foot to Cookham Lock and is only available during lock keeping hours. There is a shower room and toilet which is only available for campers and boaters. Wildlife is abundant at the lock including Woodpeckers, Kingfishers, Kestrels and even the occasional Munt Jack deer. From Good Friday to September a small lock shop is open on the weekends and most school holidays. The shop sells refreshments, ice creams, souvenirs and basic provisions.
