
## **NEIGH BRIDGE COUNTRY PARK**

## **HOW TO GET TO NEIGH BRIDGE**

MAP: OS Landranger 163, grid ref SU018947

ROAD: Download map from www.multimap.com – insert grid ref above in 'find a map' box and click 'find'. The car park is at Lake 56, north off Spine Road West, 5 miles west off the A419 between Cirencester and Cricklade (B4696 junction).

## **ROUTE DESCRIPTION**

A circular route around this peaceful lake. Please note that the path is relatively narrow (minimum of 0.9m) along the west side without any passing place.

Neigh Bridge is one of 133 lakes created by gravel extraction in the Cotswold Water Park, Britain's largest water park. It is a great place to see a range of wildlife; during winter it hosts over 20,000 waterfowl of at least 40 different species, some of which you're bound to see on a visit to this site.
